## You are a member of the magic circle, how do vou become a member?


You have to be nominated by 2 existing members of the magic circle and then go for an audition in London at the Magic Circle headquarters, which is a private members club. You have to perform for 8 minutes in front of 3 judges and an audience of magicians and are assessed on your performance, tricks and presentation. On the night I auditioned, out of 4 of us, only 3 made it. It was very nerve wracking having to perform in front of established magicians.

#### What was the first trick you ever learned to do?

It was the trick that Mark Vasey showed me called the 'Chicago Opener'. It's a brilliant trick that I still do now, but mainly I started with card tricks and progressed onto other things.
